Instructions:

- Please conduct these counts only on Tuesday, Wednesday, or Thursday.
- Ask your students “How did you arrive at school today?” Read through all of the answer choices and define carpooling. Then read the answers a second time and ask your students to raise their hands. Each student may only answer once.
- Use the same procedure for “How do you plan to leave for home after school?” Then ask about students’ travel the day before or after.

Tip: This survey can be conducted in one day by first asking students how they traveled to and from school *yesterday*. This will be Day 1 data. Then ask the students how they arrived today and will return home today. This will be the data for Day 2. The one day survey must only be done on a Wednesday or Thursday of the week.
